 - State capture
 - Corruption
 - 'Mass clientelism'



How does populism serve the interests of the powerful?

 - Undermine institutional constraints on authoritarian rule
 - Marginalize the opposition
 - Erode civil society
 - Installing loyalists in positions of power
 - Neutralizing media
