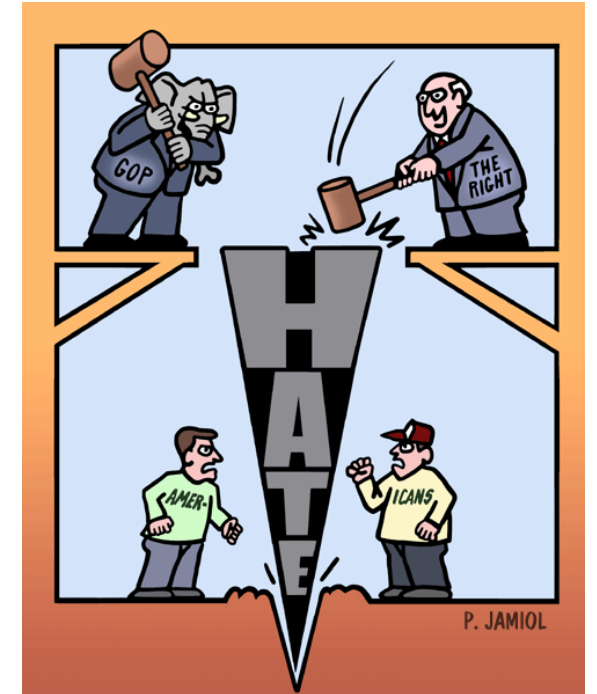
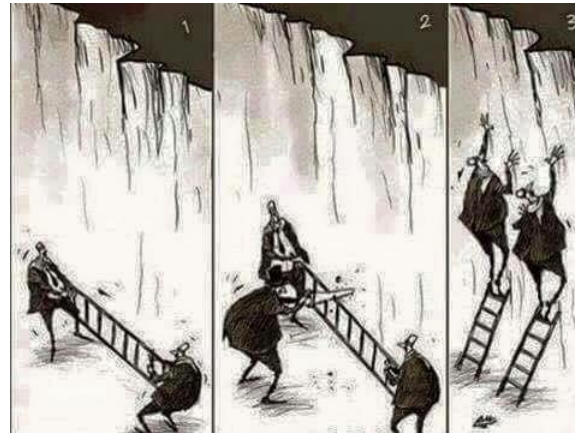
Review

 - Democratic backsliding and (re-)authoritarianization



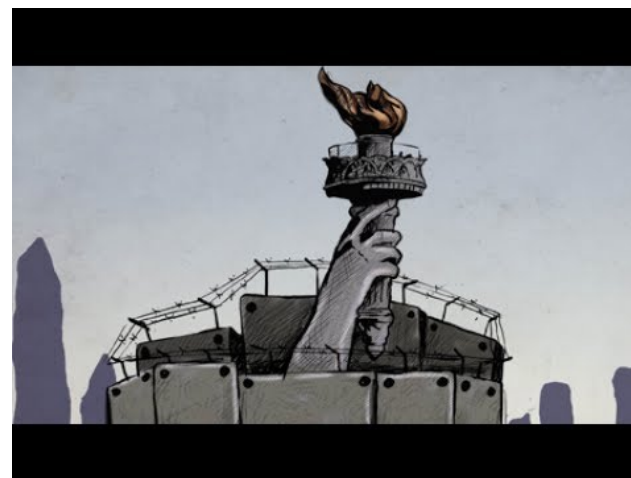
Review
