What is democracy?

- Electoral vs. substantive democracy
- Larry Diamond:
 - A political system for choosing and replacing the government through free and fair elections
 - The active participation of the people, as citizens, in politics and civic life
 - Protection of the human rights of all citizens
 - A rule of law, in which the laws and procedures apply equally to all citizens



Democracy continues its disturbing retreat


More than half the countries in the latest update of a democratic-health index saw their scores decline




The Economist Intelligence Unit's Democracy Index



Geographic distribution of regime types








Geographic distribution of democratic backsliding in Africa







FIGURE 5. CHANGE IN DEMOCRACY AND CHANGE IN INCOME, 1500-2000


FIGURE 1: GDP PER CAPITA BEFORE AND AFTER A DEMOCRATIZATION.



Democratic backsliding and inequality



Income share held by richest 10%, 2015

Percentage share of income or consumption accruing to the richest 10% of the population. In a country with 100 people, if you rank them by income the share of the top 10% corresponds to the sum of incomes of the top 10 people, as a proportion of total income in that country.
