




Figure 1.1: Protest/Riot Frequency in Sub-Saharan Africa, 1997–2016



Figure 7. Demonstrations in 2020





- Material grievances among the poor —> participation in protests

- 2019 'Tipp-Ex election' and President Peter Mutharika's reelection
- Country-wide protests
- Annulment of election results by the Constitutional Court
- 2020 election won by Lazarus Chakwera



### Political protest in Ethiopia

- 2016 Oromo protests:
  - Qeerroo and the Oromo elite (esp. Jawar Mohammed)
- Spillover into Amhara
- Oromo-Amhara alliance
- Intra-EPRDF regime reshuffle and Abiy Ahmed's rise to power in 2018

### Political protest in Uganda

- Successful mobilization of a broad-based opposition movement by Bobi Wine (Robert Kyagulanyi)
- Large-scale demonstrations against arrests and torture
- Violent crackdown
- Museveni's reelection in 2021
